# Are you eligible for this scheme?

- Settled in the UK before 1st January 1973 and have lived continuously in the UK since their arrival.
- Settled in the UK before 1st January 1973 whose settlement has lapsed.
- Have the right to abode in the UK, and were ordinarily resident on 1st January 1973.



## Group 1

- A Commonwealth Citizen who were either settled in the UK before 1st January 1973 or have the right to abode.

## Group 2

- People of any other nationality who arrived in the UK and had indefinite leave before 1st January 1973.

## Group 3

- People of any nationality, who arrived in the UK between 1st January 1973 and 31st December 1988 who have a settled status.

## Group 4

- A child of a Commonwealth citizen parent, who was settled in the UK before 1st January 1973 or had a right to abode; (or met these criteria but is now a British Citizen).
